be a typical experience turned into
a lifelong commitment to seeing
children, all over the world, receive
access to a quality education to
become local, national, and
world-changing leaders.

The seed of his hope turned into the Building Hope Project, a student sponsorship program that keeps high-need primary school students in the classroom by covering all tuition and school fees, providing uniforms, and ensuring two meals a day to successfully complete their primary education, located at Kiira Primary School. The girls and young women of Bnurd'e wanted to do a community service project to give back to those less fortunate. The mentors, parents, and girls donated items to create 100 Hygiene Bags and wrote personal notes to place in each bag for the girls at Kiia Primary School to read. The Curtiss Family left for Uganda May 23, 2022.








Empowering Girls Through Financial Literacy




Los Angeles SPARKS HBCU College Takeover
